MINUTES OF THE ORDINARY SHAREHOLDERS' MEETING OF APRIL 23, 2014

At 3:00 PM, on April 23, 2014, at the office of Mediobanca S.p.A., located at 3 via Filodrammatici, in Milan, the Ordinary Shareholders' Meeting of **DiaSorin S.p.A.** was called to order.

Pursuant to Article 10 of the Bylaws, the Shareholders' Meeting was chaired by *Gustavo Denegri*, acting in his capacity as the **Chairman of the Board of Directors.** With the unanimous consent of the attendees, the Chairman appointed as secretary of the Meeting notary *Carlo Marchetti*, who thanked him.

The Chairman then acknowledged and announced that:

- Pursuant to Article 8 of the Bylaws, the Notice of the Shareholders' Meeting was posted, within the statutory deadline, on the Company website and published, in condensed form, in the March 22, 2014 issue of the newspaper *Il Sole 24 Ore*, Finanza & Mercati Section;
- The Company did not receive any request to amend the Meeting's Agenda and no new motion was submitted, pursuant to law;
- The Company's fully subscribed and paid-in share capital amounted to 55,948,257 euros, divided into 55,948.257 common shares, par value 1 euro each. The Company holds 1,500,000 treasury shares. The voting right of has been suspended, it being understood that they will be counted to determine the quorum needed for the Meeting to be lawfully convened and to transact business, as required by Article 2357-ter, Section Two, of the Italian Civil Code.
- At that moment, 233 shareholders, representing directly or by proxy 44.300.023 common shares, equal to 79,180% of the voting share capital, were in attendance;
- The Meeting's Agenda was as follows:
- 1. Approval of the Statutory Financial Statements and the Report on Operations for the reporting year ended December 31, 2013. Motion to appropriate the year's net profit. Presentation of the Consolidated Financial Statements of the DiaSorin Group at December 31, 2013. Related and required resolutions;
- Compensation Report pursuant to Article 123-ter of Legislative Decree No. 58/1998;
- 3. Resolutions pursuant to Article 114-bis of Legislative Decree No. 58/1998

concerning the establishment of a stock option plan and connected resolutions;

- 4. Motion to elect a Director. Connected resolutions.
- In addition to the Chairman, the following Directors were in attendance: Carlo Rosa, Chief Executive Officer and General Manager, Michele Denegri, Deputy Chairman, Chen Menachem Even, Antonio Boniolo, Enrico Mario Amo, Franco Moscetti, Giuseppe Alessandria, Ezio Garibaldi, Roberta Somati, Eva Desana and Maria Paola Landini;
- The following members of the **Board of Statutory Auditors** were also in attendance: Roberto Bracchetti (Chairman) and Andrea Caretti (Statutory Auditor);
- The Statutory Auditor Ottavia Alfano was absent and excused.
- Marco Minolfo, Secretary to the Board of Directors, was also in attendance.

The <u>Chairman</u> declared that the Shareholders' Meeting was validly convened on the first calling and qualified to entertain resolutions concerning the items on the Agenda.

Before opening the floor for debate concerning the items on the Agenda, the Chairman:

- Announced that, based on information in the Shareholder Register, disclosures received pursuant to law and other available information, the following parties held, directly or indirectly, an interest greater than 2% in the Company's voting share capital:

- Announced that a schedule listing by name the parties who attended the Shareholders' Meeting personally or were represented by proxy and the number of shares held by each party would be annexed to the Minutes of the Shareholders' Meeting;
- Stated that the Company was not aware of the existence of any shareholders' agreements, as defined in Article 122 of the Uniform Financial Code;

- Asked anyone who planned to leave the Meeting prior to the start of voting to surrender their admission card to the door staff;
- Reminded the attendees that, pursuant to Article 135-undecies of the Uniform Financial Code, the Company designated SPAFID S.p.A. as the party whom eligible shareholders may appoint as their proxy agent, with voting instructions for all or some of the items on the Agenda, reporting, in this regard, that SPAFID S.p.A. did not receive any proxies;
- Indicated that the Meeting's proceedings were being taped to facilitate the subsequent drafting of the Minutes;
- Indicated that, as recommended by the Consob, representatives of the Independent Auditors, the press and the financial community, who were seated in a section at the back of the room reserved for them, were being allowed to attend the Meeting, but would not be allowed to participate in the proceedings;
- Announced that some officers and employees of the Company were being allowed to attend the Meeting to handle the proceedings' technical and organization requirements;
- Asked the attendees to refrain from using photographic, video and similar equipment, recording devices of any kind and cellular telephones inside the Meeting hall;
- reserving the right to take any action that may be appropriate to ensure an orderly progress of the proceedings and enable the attendees to exercise their rights, mentioned some of the rules of conduct applicable to the handling of Shareholders' Meetings, which the Meeting's Chairman is always required to mention at the start of each Meeting:
- -- those who wish to take the floor should inform the Secretary of their intention, specifying the items they wish to discuss;
- -- requests to be recognized may be put forth as long as the floor is open for debate;
- -- speakers shall be recognized in the order in which they have applied;
- -- eligible parties may take the floor only once with regard to any issue being debated;
- -- answers shall be provided at the end of all speeches;
- -- any party who asked to be recognized shall be allowed a brief follow-up;
- -- in order to ensure an orderly debate, shareholders are asked to keep their comments within a reasonable length of time, not to exceed about 10 minutes;
- -- should it be necessary, the Meeting may be briefly adjourned to gather the information needed to provide the required answers;
- -- the floor shall be closed when all questions, answers and follow-ups have been handled;

- -- votes shall be cast by a show of hands, with those abstaining or voting against a motion being asked to communicate to the Secretary their name and the number of votes stated on the card surrendered upon entering the Meeting, it being understood that, should the process of tallying the votes prove to be too cumbersome, staff available for this purpose would be brought in to collect copies of the entry cards and count the votes;
- Announced that no questions were submitted prior to the Shareholders' Meeting, pursuant to Article 127-ter of the Uniform Financial Code;
- Asked the attendees to disclose any situations that would exclude or limit their right to vote with regard to any of the resolutions put up for a vote.

The Chairman then turned to **the first item** on the Agenda. In view of the fact that, pursuant to law, all documents related to the item being debated had been made available at the Company's registered office and the offices of Borsa Italiana, published on the Company's website and had been provided to all attendees, moved to omit reading them. The Shareholders' Meeting approved by unanimous consent.

The <u>Chairman</u>, acting in accordance with the requirements of Consob Communication No. 96003558 of April 18, 1996, insofar as they apply to the assignment awarded to the Independent Auditors Deloitte & Touche S.p.A., communicated to the Shareholders' Meeting, in addition to the disclosures provided in the Annual Report and for the purposes of Article 149-*duodecies* of Consob Regulation No. 11971/1999, as amended, the number of hours and the fees billed by the Independent Auditors to audit and certify the statutory and consolidated financial statements at December 31, 2013:

- Statutory financial statements and tests required pursuant to Article 155, Section 1, Letter a), of Legislative Decree No. 58/1998: about 850 hours for a fee of 62,000.00 euros plus VAT, out-of-pocket expenses and cost-of-living adjustment;
- Consolidated financial statements: about 450 hours for a fee of 34,000.00 euros plus VAT, out-of-pocket expenses and cost-of-living adjustment.

At the Chairman's request, the <u>Secretary</u> read the motion concerning the appropriation of the net profit, as set forth on page 6 of the document entitled "Reports and Motions Concerning the Items on the Agenda" previously distributed to the attendees and transcribed in these Minutes.

"Dear Shareholders:

We ask you to approve the Company's statutory financial statements for the year ended December 31, 2013 and recommend that you appropriate the year's net profit of 81,836,000.60 euros as follows:

- - allocate 9,000.00 euros to the statutory reserve, thereby increasing it to an amount equal to one-fifth of the registered share capital as of the date of this resolution, which corresponds to the maximum limit set forth in Article 2430 of the Italian Civil Code;
- distribute to the shareholders 29,919,041.35euros as a dividend of 0.55 euros on each common share outstanding on the coupon presentation date, excluding treasury shares held, numbering 1,550,000 common shares;
- carry forward as retained earnings the balance of 51,907,959.25 euros.

We also recommend that the dividend be made payable starting on May 22, 2014, with coupon presentation date of May 19, 2014, to the common shares outstanding, excluding the Company's treasury shares. Pursuant to Article 83-terdecies of Legislative Decree No. 58/1998, only the parties qualifying as shareholders at the close of business on May 21, 2014 (record date) will be entitled to a dividend."

The Chairman:

- Indicated that the coupon of record is Coupon No. 8.
- Opened the floor for debate, which proceeded as follows:

Colombo, representing Etica SGR, read a speech later filed with the Office of the Chairman and transcribed below: "Honorable members of the Board of Directors and fellow shareholders of DiaSorin S.p.A., we are glad to attend for the first time your Company's Shareholders' Meeting as investors, mindful of your Company's performance both in the financial and economic area and in social and environmental terms.

Etica SGR is Italy's only asset management company exclusively devoted to establishing and promoting socially responsible mutual investment funds that invest in companies with a good social and environmental profile.

Etica SGR is part of a network of socially responsible investors and, together with some of them, including Boston Common Asset Management (2.1 billion dollars in assets under management) and CRE in the United States, we would like to focus your attention on some corporate sustainability issues.

Social and environmental reporting: We believe that reporting about business sustainability can lead to gains in operating efficient and market leadership, a stronger brand position and reputation and a better management of the supply chain.

Reporting on all aspects of business activities is being demanded and supported by <u>numerous initiatives at the global level, such as, for example,</u> the Global Reporting Initiative, a nonprofit organization that, with a multi-stakeholder approach, established the most widely used economic, social and environmental reporting standard in the world.

We are pleased to learn that DiaSorin intends to pursue <u>a process of social and environmental reporting that will result in the establishment, by 2015, of a complete Sustainability Report benefitting all Company stakeholders.</u> We recommend that the implementation of this projects also include the establishment of <u>a specific Company unit</u> responsible for the adoption of social responsibility policies that can become part of the Company's overall integrated strategy.

Environmental protection: According to a report published in 2013 by the Carbon Disclosure Project, a project launched in 2000 and currently supported by 767 institutional investors representing over 92 trillion dollars under management, which is aimed at encouraging companies to provide reports about the impact of their operations on climate change, Italian businesses, while mindful of the need to monitor CO2 emission levels, should act more like leading players in protecting the environment. It is consistent with this approach and in light of DiaSorin's decision to join the Climate Change initiative and the Carbon Disclosure Project that we are asking the Company to adopt an environmental policy that is reflective both the of the Company's current performance and of its goals in terms of emissions in the atmosphere, use of water resources and energy consumption.

We also believe that the correct use of water resources is a key factor in the adoption of a responsible conduct, given the challenges posed by the increasingly dramatic effects of climate change in many parts of the world. Consequently, we are asking DiaSorin to constantly monitor the consumption of water used in its production processes, also involving suppliers and research centers.

In this area as well, the answers provided to the "Water" questionnaire of the Carbon Disclosure Project can represent a valid tool for a more efficient monitoring and reporting of performance regarding this resource."

No other shareholder asking to be recognized, the **Chairman** thanked Etica SGR for its remarks and, with regard to the request to adopt an Environment Policy, stated that, as of the date of the Shareholders' Meeting, environmental sustainability principles were included in the Code of Ethics of the DiaSorin Group, which was available on the Company website pursuant to law. He pointed out that the Company adopted

specific5operational policies concerning Environmental and Safety issues and that, in any event, management would consider the adoption of a Policy that addresses the issues raised by Etica SGR, both in terms of performance and objectives. As for the recommendation to monitor the Company's water consumption, the Chairman stated that DiaSorin already planned to prepare a Sustainability Report and that the requested information could be included in the environmental data contained in the report.

He then emphasized that, because of the nature of its business, the Company does not engage in "polluting" activities and stated that, specifically for this reason, the recommendations made by Etica SGR would be taken into account.

- There being no shareholder who asked to be recognized, the <u>Chairman</u> closed the floor for debate and:
- having stated that there was no change in attendance,
- asked the shareholders to cast their vote by a show of hands (at 3:14 PM) for or against the motion read to them and transcribed.

The Shareholders' Meeting approved the motion unanimously.

The Chairman announced the result of the vote.

Turning to the second item on the Agenda, the Chairman:

- Reminded the attendees that, pursuant to Article 123-ter of the Uniform Financial Code all listed companies were required to prepare a Compensation Report comprised of two sections: SECTION ONE of the Report, which explains the Company's compensation policy and the procedures used to adopt and implement this policy. SECTION TWO of the Report, which lists the compensation of the management and control bodies, general managers and other executives with strategic responsibilities.

The Shareholders' Meeting is required to cast a consultative vote;

the <u>Chairman</u> also mentioned that, in accordance with the Consob Regulation governing related-party transactions, as reflected in the internal procedure adopted by the Company, the approval of the Compensation Policy by the Shareholders' Meeting relieves the Company of the obligation to apply the abovementioned procedure for related-party transactions to resolutions concerning the compensation of Directors and executives with strategic responsibilities, provided they are consistent with the Compensation Policy.

- At the Chairman's request, the <u>Secretary</u> then read the motion, as listed on page 7 of the "Report and Motions for the Items on the Agenda," previously distributed, and transcribed below:

Dear Shareholders:

As required by Article 123-ter of Legislative Decree No. 58/1998, we recommend that you vote in favor of the Company's policy concerning the compensation of governance bodies, general managers and executives with strategic responsibilities, and the procedures used to adopt and implement this policy.

Relevant information is provided in Section One of the Compensation Report, which was prepared in accordance with Annex 3A, Form 7-bis, of Consob Resolution No. 11971/99, and was made available to the public, within the statutory deadline, at the Company's registered office, at Borsa Italiana S.p.A. and on the Company website (www.diasorin.com)."

The Chairman opened the floor for debate.

Colombo, representing Etica SGR, read a speech later filed with the Office of the Chairman and transcribed below: "We appreciate the good level of detail provided in the 2013 Compensation Report, in line with the requirements of the regulatory authorities. However, we believe that it important for Diasorin to include in its compensation charts, in addition to EBIT, performance indicators that express the effectiveness and quality of the Company's activities, such as ROE and ROI, which, at the same time, can help better understand the correct composition of the compensation provided to top management in terms both of the amount and the year-over-year performance. We would have also liked to see a clear explanation of the indicators underlying the awards of options provided under the Incentive Plan on the Agenda of today's Shareholders' Meeting. It would also be important to use environmental parameter upon which the variable component of compensation would be based, such as the overall reduction of CO₂ emissions, clearly stating the respective implementation mechanisms. Lastly, in keeping with the emphasis that Etica SGR places on the definition of a fair and equitable compensation policy, we ask you to disclose, and publish in the Company's documents, the information corresponding to the ratio between the average compensation of DiaSorin's employees and that of the Chief Executive Officer, both for 2012 and 2013. We hope that our remarks will be interpreted as an encouragement to pay increasing attention to the satisfaction of all stakeholders. In thanking the Board of Directors and particularly DiaSorin's Investor Relations Unit for their willingness to entertain the recommendations of Etica SGR, we wish you a positive continuation of this Shareholders' Meeting.

No other shareholder asking to be recognized, the Chairman, addressing first the issue of the Incentive Plan, stated that its purpose was the retention of key executives and high-potential Group employees and that, at that point, the Plan was not tied to performance targets. As for the use of different performance indicators, such as ROE and ROI, the Chairman pointed out that the use of such indicators could entail significant risks: suffice it to say that, as it is well know, ROE increases with an increase in indebtedness, clearly not a positive development for the Company. He than stated his personal belief that performance plans should allow the award of bonuses even when targets cannot be reached, when this is due to external and non-controllable circumstances, noting, however, that the previous year the Company did not pay bonuses, due to the failure to achieve (albeit by a small difference) the assigned results. He concluded by stating that the ratio existing between the average Gross Annual Compensation of the Italian employees of DiaSorin S.p.A., including executives, and that of the General Manager and Chief Executive Officer was 13.4 time in 2012 and 13 times in 2013. In this regard, he then pointed out that the compensation of the Chief Executive Office is among the lowest for companies with business characteristics and size similar to DiaSorin.

There being no shareholder who asked to be recognized, the <u>Chairman</u> closed the floor for debate and

- having stated that there was no change in attendance,
- asked the shareholders to cast their vote by a show of hands (at 3:20 PM) for or against the motion read to them and transcribed.

The Shareholders' Meeting approved the motion by a majority of the votes cast.

Against: 11,128,460 shares (Vegezzi as proxy for the funds listed as opposing in the annex list).

Abstained: 148,299 shares (Vegezzi as proxy for the funds listed as abstaining in the annex list).

<u>In favor</u>: the remaining 33.023.264 shares represented at the Shareholders' Meeting.

The Chairman announced the result of the vote.

Turning to the third item on the Agenda, the Chairman:

- stated that an incentive and retention plan entitled "DiaSorin S.p.A. 2014 Stock Option Plan" pursuant to Article 114-bis of Legislative Decree No. 58/1998, reserved for executives and employees of DiaSorin S.p.A. and the Italian and Foreign companies directly or indirectly controlled by DiaSorin S.p.A., in accordance with Article 93 of the

Uniform Financial Code, implemented through the award, free of charge, of options to purchase Company treasury shares was being submitted to the shareholders for approval;

- pointed out that both the Explanatory Report of the Board of Directors provided pursuant to Article 114-bis of Legislative Decree No. 58/1998 and the Information Document prepared pursuant to Article 84-bis of the Issuers' Regulations concerning the abovementioned Plan had been made available to the public in the manner and within the deadline required pursuant to law, and included in the Reports and Motions for Resolutions, in turn deposited and published within the statutory deadline and distributed to the attendees at that day's Shareholders' Meeting. In view of these considerations, he moved to omit reading them. The Shareholders' Meeting approved by unanimous consent.

At the Chairman's request, the <u>Secretary</u> then read the motion, which is transcribed below:

"The Ordinary Shareholders' Meeting of DiaSorin S.p.A., having reviewed and approved the Explanatory Report submitted by the Board of Directors,

resolves to

- (i) approve, pursuant to and for the purposes of Article 114-bis of Legislative Decree No. 58/1998, the establishment of a new stock option plan called "DiaSorin S.p.A. 2014 Stock Option Plan" with the characteristics (including implementation conditions and requirements) specified in the Report of the Board of Directors, delegating to the Board of Directors the task of adopting the required regulations;
- (ii) grant to the Board of Directors any and all powers that may be necessary or appropriate to implement the "DiaSorin S.p.A. 2014 Stock Option Plan," including, the following non-exhaustive list being provided merely by way of example, all powers to designate the Beneficiaries and determine how many options should be awarded to each Beneficiary, proceed with the granting of Options to the Beneficiaries, and carry out all acts, required activities, formalities and communications that may be necessary or appropriate for the purpose of managing and/or implementing the Plan, with the option of delegating its powers, tasks and responsibilities in connection with the execution and implementation of the Plan to the Chairman of the Board of Directors, the Deputy Chairman and/or the Chief Executive Officer, acting jointly or severally, it being understood that the Board of Directors shall have sole jurisdiction over any decision related to and/or concerning a grant of Option to a Beneficiary who is also the

Chairman and/or Deputy Chairman and/or DiaSorin's Chief Executive Officer, as well as over any other decision related and/or pertaining to the management and/or implementation of the Plan concerning the abovementioned parties;

(iii) approve the 2014 Plan also pursuant to Article 2357-ter of the Civil Code, authorizing the Board of Director to dispose of the Company's treasury shares reserving them, in the necessary or appropriate amount and under the terms established by the 2014 Plan, to serve the 2014 Plan itself, being included the power, residually, at any time, in whole or in part, in one or more transactions, with no time limit, to sell the treasury shares on regulated markets or in compliance with further trading rules as set forth by the applicable laws, to the extent that the shares remained unsubscribed and/or otherwise held by the Company at the end of the 2014 Plan for any reason, it being understood that any disposal on regulated markets may never be executed at a price per share that is less than 15% compared with the closing price of the DiaSorin stock on the stock market trading day preceding each individual buy transaction."

The Chairman opened the floor for debate.

There being no shareholder who asked to be recognized, the <u>Chairman</u> closed the floor for debate and

- having stated that there was no change in attendance,
- asked the shareholders to cast their vote by a show of hands (at 3:22 PM) for or against the motion read to them and transcribed.

The Shareholders' Meeting approved the motion by a majority of the votes cast.

Against: 371,979 shares (Vegezzi as proxy for the funds listed as opposing in the annex list).

Abstained: 69,100 shares (Vegezzi as proxy for the funds listed as abstaining in the annex list).

In favor: the remaining 43,858,944 shares represented at the Shareholders' Meeting.

The Chairman announced the result of the vote.

Turning to the **fourth item** on the Agenda, the Chairman:

- on behalf of the entire Board of Directors, reminded the Shareholders' Meeting that the Director Gian Alberto Saporiti passed away on January 20, 2014 and, once again, extended to his family the most heartfelt condolences;
- pointed out that the Ordinary Shareholders' Meeting was being asked to elect a new Director, whose term of office would run until the expiration of the term of office of the current Board of Directors, i.e., until the date of the Shareholders' Meeting convened to

approve the financial statements at December 31, 2015. Having heard the input of the Nominating Committee, acting in accordance with the legislation in effect concerning the minimum number of independent Directors and gender parity requirements, the Board of Directors nominated for election to the post of Director Stefano Altara, born in Turin on June 4, 1967;

- in view of the fact that, pursuant to law, all documents related to the item being debated had been made available at the Company's registered office and the offices of Borsa Italiana, published on the Company's website and had been provided to all attendees, moved to omit reading them. The Shareholders' Meeting approved by unanimous consent.

At the Chairman's request, the <u>Secretary</u> then read the motion, which is transcribed below:

"The Ordinary Shareholders' Meeting of DiaSorin S.p.A.

resolves to

- elect to the post of Director Stefano Altara, born in Turin on June 4, 1967;
- set Mr. Altara's term of office as ending with the Shareholders' Meeting convened to approve the financial statements at December 31, 2015, leaving to the discretion of the Board of Directors the determination of his compensation, consistent with the resolutions adopted by the Shareholders' Meeting on April 22, 2013."

The Chairman opened the floor for debate.

There being no shareholder who asked to be recognized, the <u>Chairman</u> closed the floor for debate and

- having stated that there was no change in attendance,
- asked the shareholders to cast their vote by a show of hands (at 3:24 PM) for or against the motion read to them and transcribed.

The Shareholders' Meeting approved the motion by a majority of the votes cast.

Against: none.

Abstained: 1,785,933 shares (Vegezzi as proxy for the funds listed as abstaining in the annex list).

In favor: the remaining 42,514,090 shares represented at the Shareholders' Meeting.

The Chairman announced the result of the vote.

There being no further business to be transacted, the <u>Chairman</u> adjourned the Meeting. The time was 3:30 PM.
